



Georgia is a state in the southeastern part of the United States. It is <u>bordered</u> <u>by</u> (*dt. umrandet von*) Florida to the south, Alabama to the west, Tennessee and North Carolina to the north, and South Carolina to the east. All of Georgia's coastline is on the Atlantic Ocean. The ocean borders Georgia to the southeast.

5 Georgia <u>was established</u> (dt. wurde gegründet) in 1732 and became a state in 1788. It was the last of the original 13 colonies and eventually joined in the growing rebellion against Britain. Georgia was named after George II of Great Britain.

- English 8.1%
- Irish 8.1%

Major cities of Georgia are Atlanta (capital) with 456,000, Augusta with 201,000, and Macon with 200,000 inhabitants.
