 Peter: It's the same with Ralph. He likes to go for a walk only sometimes.

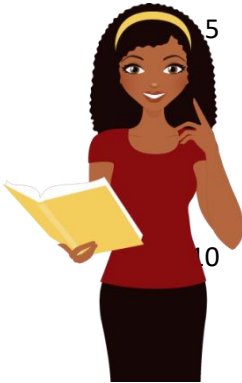
